“1. That the instant writ application has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of 'Certiorari' for quashing the order dated 04.04.14, communicated to the petitioners vide memo no.12 dt. 09.04.14, issued by the Circle Officer, Kanti, Muzaffarpur whereby he has directed the petitioners to remove the encroachment or else necessary action would be taken in complete violation of law and further prayer is to direct the respondents to settle the land in favour of the petitioners and others who are residing in the plot in question pertaining to
