petitioner and Mr. Sanjay Kumar, the learned Additional Public

Prosecutor for the State.

2. Petitioner seeks regular bail who is in custody since

03.12.2023, in connection with Meenapur P.S. Case No. 344 of

2021, FIR dated 20.09.2021, registered for the offences punishable

under Section 304(B) read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal

Code.

3. According to the prosecution case, the daughter of

the informant was subjected to regular torture and abuse by her in-

laws due to non-fulfillment of dowry demand. It is further alleged

that when the informant's daughter stopped receiving his calls, he

suspected something ominous and visited his daughter's

matrimonial home, where he found her dead and suspects that his

daughter's in-laws have murdered his daughter by strangulating



her neck.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case merely on the ground that petitioner is husband of the deceased and the allegation levelled in the FIR is false and fabricated and the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR.

5. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State on the other hand on the basis of materials available on record and case diary has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner and submits that the allegation levelled in the FIR is supported by medical evidence and apart from that the victim has received three external injuries, which suggests that petitioner and other family members had assaulted her before committing the crime in question and petitioner is husband of the deceased.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am **not** inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail in connection with Meenapur P.S. Case No. 344 of 2021, pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Muzaffarpur.

7. Prayer is refused.
