ORAL ORDER

2 15-07-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1.I. Issuance of direction order or writ in the nature of writ of mandamus or writs in the nature thereof or any other appropriate



writs/orders/directions for directing the Respondents, particularly the District Magistrate, Patna to take action against the land mafia who are trying to forcefully grab land of about 1.5 katha land in Mauza Danapur. Khata No. 774. Khesra no. 1013. Thana No. 21 (Danapur), Sub Registry-Danapur. District-Patna and provide police assistance to petitioner.

11. Issuance appropriate writs/orders/directions to direct the Respondent no.4 to produce the action taken report on the representation/complaints dated 15.04.2024.

III. To take appropriate actions against the erring respondents for committing misdeeds, misdemeanour and illegality particularly for keeping the petitioners in mental distress and harassment.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District Magistrate-Patna, for redressal of her aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
