learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 262 of 2023 in Trial No. 950 of 2023
registered for the offence under Sections 302/34 of the Indian
Penal Code and under Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner along
with three other co-accused persons have hatched the plan to
commit the loot.

4. As the petitioner was well known in the locality,
it was decided that the he will not participate in the loot and will
wait for the other co-accused to commit loot and thereafter, he
will give them shelter and the looted articles will be divided
between all the accused persons and Shanku Sah, the petitioner.



5. Loot was committed by the accused persons and while committing the loot, the deceased was killed. The accused persons thereafter came to the house of Shanku Sah, kept the looted articles there and they left.

6. From the above, it is clear that the petitioner was involved in the crime from the beginning to end and he is in custody since 22.7.2023.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Accordingly, this application is dismissed.

9. The Court below is directed to expedite the trial of the petitioner and conclude the same at the earliest.
