4 23-07-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the petitioner seeks indulgence of the writ jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Court for quashing the order dated 29.12.2020 contained in Annexure-3 passed by the Administrative Member of the Lokayukta, Bihar in Complaint No.1/Lok (Arakshi) 18/2019 whereby the aforesaid complaint has been dismissed or be pleased to pass any other Order/s, Writ/s or



direction/s which your Lordships deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the instant case.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of approaching the Collector, Vaishali at Hajipur, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed.
