with Dumariyaghat P.S. Case No. 162 of 2023, registered for the

offence punishable under Sections 323, 341, 354-B/34 of the

FIR against the petitioner, as well as, the statement of the victim



recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C., I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

4. It goes without saying that the learned Trial Court must expedite the trial and conclude the same expeditiously as the petitioner is under trial and any further delay will affect his right as enshrined under Article-21 of the Constitution of India.
