2 26-06-2024 Heard Mr. Anshu Dhar Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Mr. Dilip Kumar No.1, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the FIR, the petitioners along with other co-accused persons brutally assaulted the informant's side by means of several weapons.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence.



They have been falsely implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is no specific overt act against the petitioners and the injuries sustained by the injured person are of simple nature. There is a case and counter-case between the parties. Petitioners have one criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as well as considering the nature of injury, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No.304 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
