9 13-08-2024 Heard Mr. Sanjay Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Anurag Singh, learned CGC for the Union of India.

2. The only interference the petitioner seeks from this Court is in respect of the quantum of punishment being disproportionate to the gravity of the charge.

3. Considering the aforesaid records relating to the disciplinary action taken against the petitioner, as well as, the charge, I do not find to interfere in any manner with the penalty order awarded to the petitioner, which commensurates with the



gravity of the offence committed by the petitioner.

4. The present writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
