22 05-10-2024 Pursuant to the order dated 03.12.2018
passed by this Court in C.W.J.C. No. 16107 of 2004,
District Selection Committee convened and

2. By resolution dated 21.08.2019, it was
found that from the panel prepared in the year 2004,
it would legally untenable to give appointment to the
candidates on Group D posts.

3. In view of the said resolution of the
District Selection Committee, no case for initiating
