ORAL ORDER

2 07-05-2024 Heard Mr. Ravindra Singh, learned counsel for the
petitioner and Mrs. Renu Kumari, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in Aunsi P.S. Case No. 04
of 2024, corresponding to G.R. No. 296 of 2024, instituted for
the offences punishable under Sections 272, 273/34 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that, 495 liters
liquor was recovered from khar-patwar near an abandoned
biscuit factory. The petitioner was apprehended on spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from



the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. It is further submitted that the alleged recovery has been made from an open place which is easily accessible to everyone. The petitioner is in custody since 11.03.2024 and has got no criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 100 of Cr.P.C.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Aunsi P.S. Case No. 04 of 2024.
