3 14-08-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this writ application has been

following the procedure established under land acquisition Act.”

At the outset, the learned counsels for the respondents unanimously submit that since the land of the petitioner in question has not been acquired, no direction has been issued by the respondents to demolish any construction made over the aforesaid land of the petitioner, hence the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
