2 13-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That, this is an application for issuance of appropriate writ(s) / direction(s) for quashing the order dated 07.01.2021 passed by the respondent no.4 in Anganbari Appeal Case No.83/2018-19 by which he has allowed the appeal filed by the respondent no.8 and set aside the order dated 27.06.2018 passed by the respondent no.5, by which the



respondent no.5 has cancelled the selection of the respondent no.8 from the post of Anganbari Sevika at newly created additional Anganbari Centre at ward no.06, Gram Panchayat Raj Khalwan, Block-Nautan, District-Siwan."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit before the learned civil court of competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
