seeking the following reliefs:-

*“1. I. For issuance of writ in the nature
of Mandamus, commanding &
directing the respondent authorities to
get the land of the petitioner vacated
from the encroachers in view of order
dated 23.12.2013, passed in BLDR
Case No. 174/2012-13 by the
respondent no. 3 and hand over*



the possession of the same to the petitioner.

II. For issuance of further writ in the nature of Mandamus, commanding & directing the respondent authorities to provide adequate protection to the life & property of the petitioner.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances including filing execution case for compliance of the order dated 23.12.2013 passed by the Deputy Collector Land Reforms, Kishanganj in BLDR Case No. 174/2012-13. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
