no.637 dated 09.09.2014, passed by
the Secretary, Road Construction
Department, Bihar, Patna, by which he
has been pleased to reject the claim of
the petitioners. The petitioners further
pray for issuance of a direction to the*



respondent authorities to construct the State Highways No.81 (SH-81) on the eastern side of the bank of the Koilwar Canal so that minimal land is used for the said construction.”
