3 31-07-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

“1. (A) writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ/order or directions commanding the respondent Commissioner of the Patna Municipal Corporation to demolish the unauthorised structure of the Market Complex constructed by the Private Respondent over society plot no. C 23 without sanction of the Building Plan



and in sheer violation of the mandatory provisions of front and rear set-back as provided in the Building Bye-Laws of the Patna Regional Development Authority (Dissolved) and now the Patna Municipal Corporation.”

2. Considering the nature of relief sought for in the present writ petition, I deem it fit and proper to grant liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondent State authorities for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
