2. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1(i). That this petition is filed for issuance of writ / writ, order/orders and direction/directions to the respondents in the nature mandamus /certiorari to the respondents authorities for



clearance of the encroached govt. land which is a (Gairmajarua Aam) Village Khairi, Mauja-Jatwa, Block-Banjaria, District- East Champaran, the Land which is encroached by respondent No. 7 to 11 is having, Khata -1371, Khesra-44.”
