ORAL ORDER

2 15-07-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this instant writ application is being filed on behalf of the petitioner in the nature of writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions upon



the respondents to remove the encroachment on the land of Public Road, Bihar Government bearing Khata No. 157, Khesra No. 236 and the Land of Ram Janki Mandir bearing Khata No. 117, Khesra No. 238 and 302 situated at Village-Afjalpur, encroached by the Respondent No. 7 to 11.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Respondent No. 5 i.e. the Circle Officer, Sahdei Bujurg, District Vaishali, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. It is needless to state that in case appropriate petition is filed by the petitioner, under the provisions of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, before the Respondent No. 5, within a period of four weeks from today, he shall take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, forthwith.

4. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
