seeking the following relief:-

"1. A) That the instant writ application is being filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing and commanding the respondent authorities in particular the Circle Officer Narkatiaganj (Respondent No. 5) to take measurement and thereafter to remove encroachment from the road as directed by the Sub- Divisional Magistrate, Narkatiaganj
