ORAL ORDER

3 14-08-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate Writ, order of direction, particularly in the nature of writ of Mandamus commanding the respondents to remove encroachments made by the musclemen of the village who have not only encroached the school land but have also obstructed construction of boundary wall, three room building, toilet and



kitchen shed for which State had provided fund to the school. Writ petitioner prays for a direction to the district administration authorities to make school premises encroachment free and demolish all construction created by the encroachers, and declare them trespassers."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the respondent-State submits, on instructions, that the encroachment in question has already been removed, however, in case any encroachment is still existing, the same would definitely be removed, by taking recourse to the due process of law, forthwith.

3. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed off.
