2 23-05-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered
for the offence under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per allegation in the FIR, it is a case
wherein the informant who is field officer of Micro Capital
Limited and after collection of Rs.17,350/- while returning two
unknowns persons snatched the money along with other articles.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in
this case, nothing has been recovered from the conscious pos-
session of the petitioner and the name of the petitioner figured
on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Vishwajeet



Kumar @ Vikash Kumar and petitioner is in custody since 15.02.2024.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State, opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances and submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail **after framing of the charge** in connection with Baniyapur P.S. Case No. 11 of 2023 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Chapra (Saran).

7. The trial court is directed to conclude the proceeding of framing of charge according to law within a period of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that ***if the charge-sheet has not been submitted*** then the above named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond with further condition that the petitioner has to present physically on each and every date before the Trial Court till conclusion of the trial.
