following relief:-

*“1- That this Writ application is being filed for issuance
of appropriate writ or writs or under by Commanding the
Respondents to pay the balance amount which is due to
be paid by the office of the Respondent no. 3 on account
of Work done by the petitioner with regard to Nal Jal
Yogana Plan, whereby Water has been supplied in every
