2 17-05-2024 1. The present petition has been filed for restoration
of a writ petition bearing CWJC No.4303 of 2024, which has
stood dismissed on account of non-prosecution, by an order
dated 22.03.2024.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has
submitted that on account of inadvertence, the aforesaid case
could not be marked in the daily cause list of that particular day
on which the said case was called out for hearing, resulting in
his non-appearance, leading to the dismissal of the case for non-
appearance, thus a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid
writ petition be restored to its original file.
