2 15-07-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this Writ Application is being filed for
issuance of writ in the nature of writ of
mandamus or any other appropriate
writ/order/direction commanding the
Respondents to bring a logical conclusion to
the Encroachment Case No. 7/23-24 initiated
for removal of encroachment from a public
road which is north boundary of Thana No.
250, Khesra No. 3421 (new), Area 14 1/2*



Dhur situated in Mauza- Rampur Raut, P.O. + Block - Kusheshwar Asthan (East), Sub-Division-Biraul, Darbhanga, Bihar.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction upon the Circle Officer, Kusheshwar Asthan (East), District-Darbhangha to conclude the proceedings of the pending Encroachment Case No.07/23-24.

3. *Per contra*, the learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the aforesaid encroachment proceedings have not yet been concluded, the same shall definitely be concluded, within a stipulated time frame, as is fixed by this Court.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to direct the Circle Officer, Kusheshwar Asthan (East), District-Darbhangha to conclude the proceeding of the aforesaid Encroachment Case No.07/23-24, in case the same has not yet been concluded, by passing the final order, under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, after



hearing the affected parties and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

5. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
