ORAL ORDER

2 14-05-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Excise (Motihari) P.S. Case No. 593 of 2024 dated 04.04.2024 registered for the offences punishable under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, 34.2 litres of illicit Nepali country made liquor kept in a sack was recovered near the tree and 11.4 litres of illicit country made liquor kept in a sack was recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has four criminal antecedents and in all cases he is on bail as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 05.04.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Excise (Motihari) P.S. Case No. 593 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
