ORAL ORDER

2 23-05-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered
for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

3. As per allegation in the FIR, total 300 liters of
country made liquor was recovered from the conscious posses-
sion of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in
this case and no independent witness of seizure list, he has no
concern with the seized liquor and petitioner has got clean an-
tecedent and he is in custody since 01.04.2024.



5. Learned APP appearing for the State, opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances and submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail *after framing of the charge* in connection with Town P.S. Case No. 205 of 2024 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Ist Special Judge, Excise, Saran at Chapra.

7. The trial court is directed to conclude the proceeding of framing of charge according to law within a period of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that *if the charge-sheet has not been submitted* then the above named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond with further condition that the petitioner has to present physically on each and every date before the Trial Court till conclusion of the trial.
