2 29-07-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this is an application for issuance of writ/writs, rule/rules, direction/directions to the respondents to provide the information forthwith as demanded by the petitioner under the prescribed form vide her application dated 05.01.2023 submitted before the District Education Officer, Siwan-cum-Public Information Officer and other application under R.T.I. Act submitted before



the Regional Deputy Director, Education Department, Saran, Chapra vide application dated 17.03.2023 and application (Dairy No.A/P/060723/11015) submitted before State Information Commission, Bihar on 03.07.2023 and further for a direction to the State Information Commission, Bihar to enquire about not supply of the aforesaid information and proceed further as per law within a certain time frame."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
