following relief(s):-

*“1. That the instant writ application is being
filed for issuance of appropriate writ/writs,
order/orders, direction/directions for directing
the respondent authorities, especially District
Magistrate, Darbhanga, for removal of road,
which has been constructed in the Khatiyani
land of the petitioner appertaining to Khata*



No.125, Plot No.79, situated at village-Nadiyami, Police Station-Sakatpur, District-Darbhanga.

For directing the respondents to construct the road on the land which has already been left by the original land holder for common path on the western side, which has been encroached by Jatadhar Choudhary, Hare Kant Jha and the private respondents.”
