2 15-01-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the present writ application is being filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 19.10.2022 vide letter No. RKS/PTR/434/2022 issued by Respondent no. 5 in-charge Medical Officer as contained in Annexure-5 and by the issuance of writ of



Mandamus direct the respondents authority to re-instate the petitioner on the post of Asha Facilator from the date in which she joined and to issue any other appropriate writ or writs / direction or directions, commanding the respondents to appoint the petitioner on the Post of Asha Facilator and or pass any such direction for which the petitioner is entitled."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
