2 22-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as
learned APP for the State.

2. In this case, the petitioners are seeking regular
bail in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 430 of 2023,
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 25(1-b)A,
26 of the Arms Act.

3. As per allegation, police received a secret
information that one accused of Khaira P.S. Case No. 242/21 is
in the process of leaving the jurisdiction of police station. The
police rushed the place of occurrence and arrested the petitioner
who was attempting to flee away. From his possession, a
country-made pistol and live cartridges were recovered.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that out of 16 cases pending against the petitioner, he has been acquitted in 7 cases and in 4 cases he has been granted bail. The petitioner is under custody since 13.10.2023.

5. Considering the fact that a country made pistol and live cartridges were recovered from the possession of the petitioner and also considering the strong criminal antecedents of the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for bail is rejected.

6. Learned court below is directed to expedite the trial.
