ORAL ORDER

2 17-05-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in
connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 15 of 2024 instituted for
the offences under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Amendment Act.

3. As per prosecution case, there have been recovery
of 17.385 liters of illegal foreign liquor and 3.800 liters of
Masaledar wine from the house of co-accused Ramesh Kumar
Gupta and from other places.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has
committed no offence. The name of the petitioner has come into



light on the basis of disclosure made by local villagers. Petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is next submitted that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Petitioner has no knowledge regarding the alleged occurrence. There is no compliance of Section 100 of the Cr.P.C.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court below/concerned Court in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 15 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
