The present M.J.C./Contempt Petition is filed for non-compliance of the orders of this Court dated 14.02.2022 passed in C.W.J.C. No.8512 of 2021, whereas the present M.J.C./Contempt Petition is filed on 18.05.2023.

2. The present M.J.C./Contempt Petition is not maintainable in the light of the Co-ordinate Bench decision of this Court in the case of **Dr. Rajesh Kumar Sinha and others Vs. The Union of India ad others (M.J.C. No.1840 of 2023)** read with the recent decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **S. Tirupathi Rao Versus M. Lingamaiah and Others decided on 22nd of July, 2024 {2024 SCC OnLine SC 1764}**.
