APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends her arrest in connection  
with Suiya P.S. Case No. 73 of 2023 for the offences punishable  
under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The petitioner is the mother-in-law of the deceased.  
The allegation is of demand of dowry and torture against her.  
The police after investigation has exonerated the petitioner and  
submitted final form, but the Magistrate has taken cognizance  
after differing with the final form.

4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on  
behalf of the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case  
and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, in the event



of arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks from today, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka in connection with Suiya P.S. Case No. 73 of 2023, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
