2 04-01-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief(s):-

“1. That the present writ application is being filed in the nature of Mandamus for a direction to the Bihar State Subordinate Service Commission to provide marks of the petitioner in mains examination which was conducted on 29.11.2020 in relation to Advertisement No. 1 of 2019 for appointment of Police Sub-Inspector of the petitioner bearing Roll No. 6511120781 in the BC category; on the ground that the petitioner's exam for mains was better much more than 75% and the Commission is having one copy of the mains paper, the cut off for mains is 72.6% and the final selection



is for 72.8% in BC category;
II. That the present writ application is being filed in the nature of Mandamus for a direction to the Bihar State Subordinate Service Commission to consider and appoint the petitioner on the post of Police Sub-Inspector in relation to Advertisement No.1 of 2019 if having more or equal marks of final cut off as 72.8% in BC category.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent-authorities for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
