ORAL ORDER

2 22-05-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered
for the offence under Sections 272, 273 and 414/34 of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise
Act, 2022.

3. As per allegation in the FIR, 90 liters of illicit
liquor has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in
this case and no independent witness of seizure list and peti-
tioner is in custody since 19.03.2024.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State, op-



poses the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances and submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail *after framing of the charge* in connection with G.R. No.373 of 2024 arising out of Basopatti P.S. Case No. 42 of 2024 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge Excise Act, Madhubani.

7. The trial court is directed to conclude the proceeding of framing of charge according to law within a period of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. However, it is made clear that *if the charge-sheet has not been submitted* then the above named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond with further condition that the petitioner has to present physically on each and every date before the Trial Court till conclusion of the trial.
