2 25-07-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

"(i) For issuance of a writ(s) direction/s, order/s in the nature of mandamus, the petitioner seeks to command and direct the respondent authorities to prevent from encroaching upon the public road by creating the wall. The petitioner further requests an order prohibiting the any kind of construction on public road and demolished the construction (wall) on so far made by respondent.

(ii) The petitioner argues that respondents no.



1 to 5s are unmistakably involved in the illegal act of encroaching upon the public property which is use for public road to way of BABA AMAR SINGH ASTHAN, creating a clear case of land encroachment. The petitioner underscores the pressing need for judicial intervention to promptly halt these actions and address the encroachment situation."

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Rosera, District-Samastipur for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
