2. The District Magistrate, Darbhanga is hereby requested to verify whether was there any FIR for benefit of subject matter of vehicle on 11.02.2023. If it is so, the vehicle shall be released in favour of the petitioner after taking bank guarantee for a period of three months. In the meanwhile, confiscation proceeding shall be completed.

3. In the confiscation proceedings, the concerned



authority is hereby directed to take note of description of the vehicle including name and other details of the vehicle. The vehicle shall be released within a period of three weeks from today
