seeking the following relief:-

"1. That the present writ application is being filed for compliance of the order dated 04.10.2018 passed by learned Sub-Divisional Public Grievance Redressal Officer, Block- Kanti, District- Muzaffarpur, whereby and where under learned Sub-Divisional Public Grievance Redressal Officer was pleased to pass the order dated 04.10.2018 with direction to the Circle Officer that the petitioner is landless lady, she has not any residential land, take legal action for making residential
