It transpires to this Court that *vide* order dated 20.03.2024, also no one appears on behalf of the petitioners and it was informed at Bar that counsel for the petitioners namely Mr. Manindra Nath Tiwari, Advocate is no more and in this view of the matter, this Court has directed the office to issue notice directly to the petitioners at their respective address.
