2. Learned counsel for the State on instruction submitted that such *Jamabandi* proceedings would be completed within a period of four months. In the light of these developments, the present M.J.C. No. 1580 of 2021 stands dropped, reserving liberty to the petitioner to file Interlocutory Application for revival of this order in the event of non-completion of *Jamabandi* proceedings within an outer limit of five months.

3. *Mr. Gajendra Kumar Jha*, learned counsel for the opposite party nos. 8 and 9 seeks permission to participation of the respondents in the *Jamabandi* proceedings. The concerned official who undertakes *Jamabandi* proceedings is/are hereby directed to hear the respondent nos. 8 and 9 in the *Jamabandi* proceedings.
