a writ petition bearing CWJC No.14807 of 2023, which has  
  
stood dismissed on account of non-prosecution, by an order  
  
dated 30.04.2024.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted  
  
that on account of inadvertence, the learned counsel for the  
  
petitioner could not mark the case in the daily cause list and
