*“1(i) For issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the provisional seniority list dated 07.01.2019 published by the respondents.*

*(ii) For issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the respondents to publish a fresh seniority list giving seniority to the petitioners according to the marks obtained by them in the selection process.”*

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners



seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the Commandant, BMP-5, Bihar, Patna i.e. the respondent no.05 for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.
