4      09-08-2024                      Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and  
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner is in custody in connection  
with Nawada Town P.S Case No. 679 of 2021 registered  
for the offences punishable under Sections 33, 34 and  
36 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

3. As per prosecution case, many persons died  
due to consumption of spurious liquor which was  
purchased from some unknown persons.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits  
that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. It



is further submitted that no incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is not named in FIR whereas petitioner's name transpired on the basis of confessional statement of the co-accused. Petitioner is in custody since 24.08.2023. Similarly situated co-accused persons, namely, Kaushal Yadav, Suraj Kumar, Vidhan Yadav, Utpalkant @ Babloo Kumar and Pramod Yadav have already been granted bail by Co-ordinate Bench in Cr. Misc. Nos. 50145 of 2023, 50163 of 2023, 50905 of 2023, 51299 of 2023, 12269 of 2024 and 71747 of 2023 vide orders dated 16.08.2023, 27.02.2024 and 10.04.2024 respectively.

5. However, learned APP for the State oppose the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

6. On perusal of the FIR, impugned order and period of custody and also considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds



of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Judge-I, Nawada in connection with Nawada Town P.S Case No. 679 of 2021.
