4 06-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Supaul P.S.
Case No. 815 of 2022 registered for the offence punishable
under Sections 302, 379, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Vide order dated 20.06.2024, a report was called for,
regarding the stage of trial. In compliance thereof, a report sent
by learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Supaul dated
26.06.2024 is kept at flag 'R', whereby it is submitted that in
this case out of eight witnesses, six witnesses have been
examined. It is further submitted that the trial of this case will
likely to be concluded within 3 months from today.

4. Considering the submissions made in the report, I am



not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner named above. The prayer for bail is hereby rejected.

5. Accordingly, the bail application is dismissed.

6. However, the trial court is directed to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
