seeking the following reliefs:-

“1. i) For issuance of an appropriate writ / order, direction to respondents for selection in police S.I., Sergeant, A.S.J. (Direct & Ex-Servicemen) in Advertisement No.01/2019 whenever both have passed final exam but due to not send, the final paper documentation dated 25.02.2021 and 24.02.2021 respectively of petitioners whenever neither advertise it in paper nor sent to website nor sent through E-



mail.

(ii) For issuance of an appropriate writ / order, direction to respondents for giving a chance also to these petitioners to take part in without of ex-service man of 357 as according to circular of Respondent No. 5 by which it will be documentation upcoming on 12.04.2021."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with the efflux of time though the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous, however, the Bihar Police Subordinate Service Commission, Patna be directed to take all measures to ensure that the website being maintained by them works efficiently. It is directed accordingly.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
