*“That this writ application is being filed for setting
aside the order dated 9.11.2020 passed by the State
Information Commissioner, Patna in connection
with Case No. A4597/2017 (Dhanjay Jha Versus
First Appellate Tribunal-cum-Sub-Divisional
Officer Mahua, Vaishali/Public Information
Officer-cum-Circle Officer Goroul Vaishali,*



whereby the respondents concern has directed to impose penalty of Rs.25,000/- of the petitioner for not providing the information to the Private respondent and also directed to give information to respondents concern for necessary action.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case it is directed that imposition of penalty of Rs.25,000/- by the State Chief Information Commissioner, State Information Commission, Patna, vide order dated 09.11.2022 shall not cast any aspersion on the service career of the petitioner.
