ORAL ORDER

- 3 18-10-2024 The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No. 5115 of 2024, which has stood dismissed for non-prosecution, vide order dated 4.4.2024.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the aforesaid case could not be marked in the daily cause list on 4.4.2024, resulting in the counsel being unable to attend the case



when the case was called out for hearing, leading to dismissal of the aforesaid petition for non-prosecution, hence, a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid petition be restored to its original file.
