2 04-01-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

"(i) For issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 08.07.2021 passed by respondent no.3 in Anganbari Appeal Case No. 25/2018 by which he has affirmed the order dated 22.05.2017 passed by District Programm Officer, Gopalganj in Anganbari Appeal No.46/2018.



ii) For issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 22.05.2018 passed by District Programm Officer, Gopalganj in Anganbari Appeal No.46/2018 by which appeal filed by petitioner challenging the selection of respondent no. 7 as Anganbari Sevika in no. 2 has been rejected."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
