3 22-04-2024 The present MJC is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 31.01.2022 passed in CWJC No. 19008 of 2021. Respondents have filed show cause along with annexure-A dated 29.09.2022, it is a speaking order therefore limited direction issued by this Court in CWJC No. 19008 of 2021 to the extent that petitioner was permitted to submit representation within a period of four weeks from 31.01.2022. Petitioner had



filed representation on 18.02.2022. Due to inaction of the respondent, petitioner had filed reminder on 31.05.2022. Thereafter, the present contempt petition was filed. During the pendency of the contempt petition, petitioner was aware of the order dated 29.09.2022 vide annexure-A to the show cause by which it is evident that there is compliance to orders of this Court and it was subject matter of CWJC No. 16555 of 2022 and CWJC No. 16555 of 2022 has been withdrawn by the petitioner. No reasons have been assigned as to what made petitioner to withdraw. Taking note of these facts and circumstances, the present contempt petition do not survive for consideration and it is dropped.
