6 13-03-2024 Heard Mr. Sanjay Kumar No.-7, learned Counsel for the petitioners and Mr. Anand Kumar Ojha, learned Counsel who represent the opposite party.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 01.05.2018 in C.W.J.C. No. 16964 of 2017, a show cause has been filed on behalf of the opposite party annexing the document relating to Rajesh Kumar Pandey and Pradeep Yadav to show that the agreement signed with the petitioners have been annulled.

3. Though 14 petitioners are there, only two



documents is/are on record.

4. Mr. Anand Kumar Ojha submits that he has complete information that against all, a decision has been taken and he will be procuring all the documents related to rest of the petitioners and will serve it to Mr. Sanjay Kumar No. 7 by Monday.
