2 16-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, and the
State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under sections 406, 420, 34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

2. It is a case of cash for job.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner denies
the prosecution case. Agreement to secure appointment by
unfair means is itself unlawful and prohibited under the law.
Informant cannot be allowed to urge that he has been cheated.
Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

4. Considering the fact that offering a bribe for getting
a job is itself illegal and an offence, prayer for bail of the
petitioner is allowed. In the event of arrest/surrender within six
weeks from today, let the petitioner, mentioned above, be



enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai, in Begusarai Police Station Case No. 248/2022, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure
